




















About GAF Conferences


The journey to the Gender in Aquaculture & Fisheries Section of the Asian Fisheries Society has been a slow and steady one spanning two and a half decades. We have highlighted gender issues in the sector by organising global conferences and until GAF6, we partnered with the Asian Fisheries Society's Triennial Forum as a side event. GAF7 was our first independent conference, organised at Thailand. GAF8 is our second independent event, the 8th in the formal series of Conferences.

Through this long journey we have been able to bring to the fore issues and discuss potential solutions, gained new insights and built networks of like-minded people from various parts of the globe working on similar lines and sharing common concerns.

While problems still persist, there has also been some light, with increased awareness on why we should be looking at aquaculture and fisheries through the gendered lens. We have also facilitated information and knowledge sharing through our conferences, publications, website* and social media. The path to gender equality and justice stretches as we continue to address issues, share success stories and experiences through the triennial GAF Conferences. The eight in the series, GAF8, will be held at Kochi, Kerala, India with the theme Shaping the Future: Gender Justice for Sustainable Aquaculture & Fisheries.
