GENDER PERSPECTIVE IN CBFM

- Gender inclusion is the central priority in CBFM work
- In the development of the CBFM plan, full participation is required to gather information on different Gender group fishing activities.
- In our culture, men are widely known as decision-makers, and that creates barriers for recognising women in decision-making.
- This is knowing that participation is not enough in CBFM work.



STRENGTHENING GENDER IN CBFM

- Establishment of the Women's Association in different communities
 - Registered and eligible for seeking grants
 - to support the implementation of fisheries management plan
 - Recognising their value in enhancing food security and nutrition through their initiatives
- Collaborate with Government Ministries and Non-government agencies for conducting training such as Financial literacy, Waste repurposing, Post-harvest and Value adding training.
- Assistance in writing grants for Communities regarding their needs.


